Young Benefactor Event Co-Chair	1-2 people for each event	Work alongside the YB Executive Committee to plan an event (See below). Responsibilities include communications, coordinating vendors and service providers, working with Event Hosts and other YB volunteers to solicit attendees, organize silent auction items, and other key details. - YB Kickoff Event - 19th Hole on the Square Event (April 27) - Happy Hours	Medium
Young Benefactor Event Host	As many as interested	Responsible for assisting Event Co-Chairs to invite attendees and help with other event related items, as needed.	Low
Young Benefactor Chair of Silent Auctions	1-2 people	Responsible for soliciting silent auction items for event throughout the year. This is a very important role as silent auctions have generated a majority of funds, raised at past events. Past donors include Chelsea Piers, Drive495, Vineyard Vines, Diageo, various area golf courses such as Friars Head, Deepdale, Sebonack and many others	Medium
Young Benefactor Chair of Partnerships and Sponsorships	1-2 people	Responsible for soliciting partnerships to: (a) grow YB membership, (b) generate event-specific sponsorship and (c) pursue other mutually beneficial partnerships. Could include partnerships with other young professional networks, graduate schools, private clubs, and like-minded non-profit organizations. Event sponsorships could come from any corporate or other source with goal of provide monetary funding or other products and/or services to benefit TFTMNY.	Medium
Young Benefactor Marketing & Design	1 person	TFTMNY and YB calendar of event includes many communications to donors, attendees, sponsors, etc. We are looking for someone with a background in graphic design to help create invitations, activity updates, website materials, and other various marketing materials. Will include working with the YB Executive Committee, Event Chairs and the TFTMNY Communications Team.	Low
